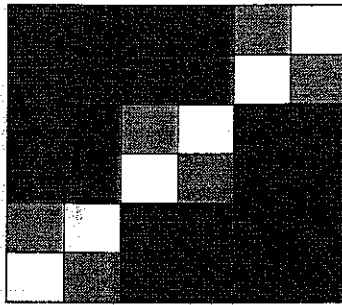


Four Patch Chain

GMQG Group Quilt 2009-2010

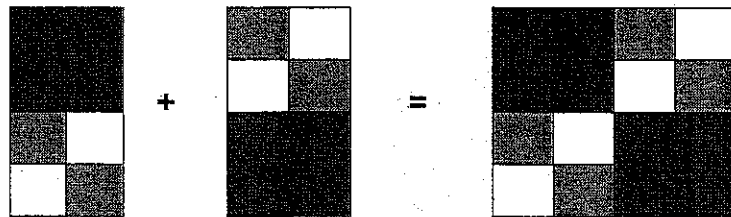


1. Sew each light 2" square to the medium 2" squares. Stitch the units together in pairs as shown to make three four-patch units. Each four-patch unit **MUST** measure 3 1/2" at this stage.



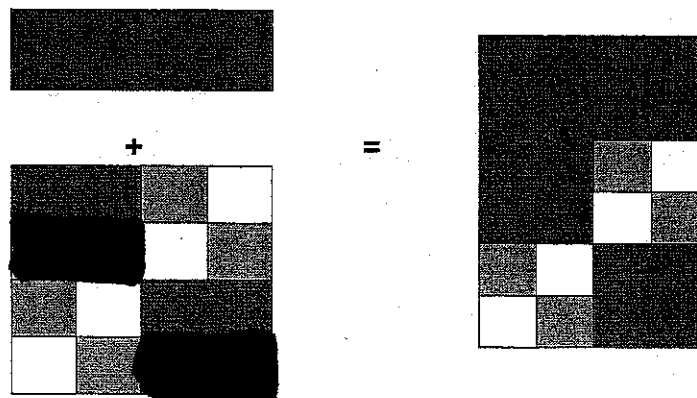
Make 3

2. Sew the dark 3 1/2 "squares to two of the four-patch units as shown, then stitch the units together. Be sure the four-patch units are oriented in the correct direction so that the chain of light squares runs diagonally across the block. Unit **MUST** measure 6 1/2" square at this stage

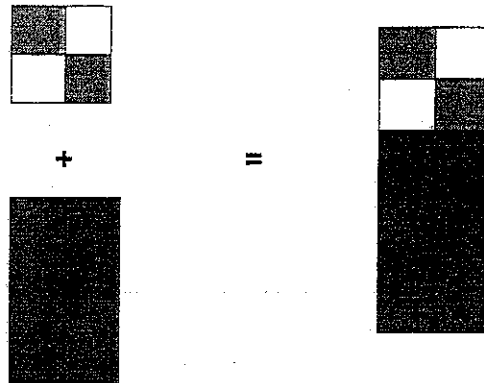


Make 2

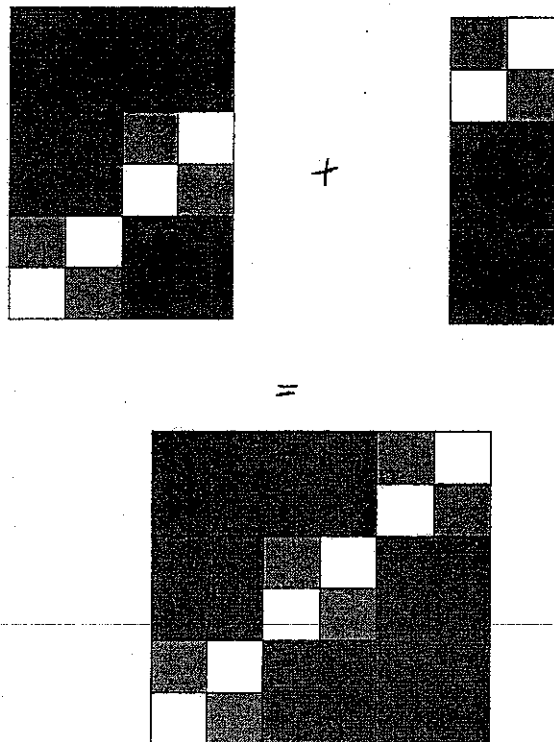
3. Stitch a dark rectangle to the top of the unit from step 2 as shown. Unit **MUST** measure 9 1/2" x 6 1/2" at this stage.



4. Stitch the remaining dark rectangle to the remaining four-patch unit as shown. Unit MUST measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " at this stage.



5. Sew the unit from step 4 to the right-hand side of the unit from step 3 to complete the block.



Block MUST measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.....no exceptions.
