

GMQG..Mystery Quilt 2007 Part 2

Last month you cut nine 2 ½" X 10 ½" strips from 5 fabrics, and you sewed them together to make a nine patch that measures about 30" square.



Step 1

Using the same five fabrics cut ten 2 ½" squares and sew them together as in the picture below. Then sewn the rows together.

You need to make two blocks like this. When finished they should measure about 10 ½" square.

Step 2.

Using the sixth fabric cut 8 WOF 2 ½" strips. Then sew the strips around all three blocks.



10 ½ " square,, make 2



30" square,, make 1
