

## Make-Do Mystery 2009

---

### PART TWO:

1. Cut 2 - 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of background fabric. Cut twice diagonally.
  2. Cut 2 - 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of dark fabric. Cut twice diagonally.
  3. Sew all background triangles to the dark triangles.
  4. Press carefully (you're working with bias edges) towards the dark. You should now have 8 half squares.
  5. Sew each half square to another along the long edge. Press seams to one side carefully.
  6. Trim blocks to 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". You should have 4 - "Four X" blocks.
- Yippee!!! You have finished Part Two!!
