Again this year we will offer the pattern for both a full quilt and a wall hanging.

This year the wall hanging will be suitable for a door hanging.

Full quilt size is 50 x 62 without borders. And 63 x 75 with borders.

Wall hanging is 14 x 50 without borders and 27 x 63 with borders.

The first block is a RAIL FENCE in scraps of **red** and **brown** fabrics.



Cut strips of 1 1/8" wide.

Quilt:

3 FQ (18x22") cut 7 strips of each FQ in **browns** and **reds**. Sew together in strips and then cut the strips in 2 1/2" blocks. You need 50 blocks.. Sew the blocks in rotation as in the picture. The final block should measure 2 1/2" x 10 1/2". You need 10 of the final rail fence blocks.

Wall Hanging:

3 F8ths (9"x11") Cut 3 strips of each in **reds** and **browns**. Sew together in strips and then cut the strips in 2 1/2" blocks. You need 10 blocks. Sew the blocks in rotation as in the picture. The final block should measure 2 1/2" x 10 1/2". You need 2 of the final rail fence blocks.
