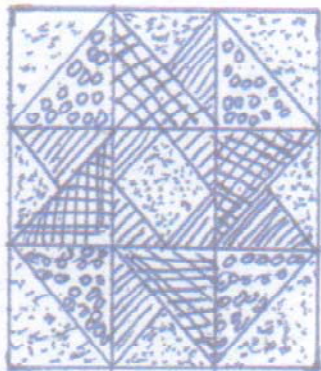

Air Castle 6 1/2" sq unfinished



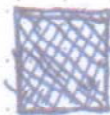
This is a basic nine patch. There are three different blocks and you must pay attention to how they go together. I will be giving instructions for the wall hanging.. If you are making the full size quilt then multiply the pieces by five. Again use all fabrics of the same value.



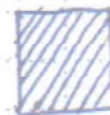
Fab 1 Cut 1... 3 1/4" squares cut on the diagonal twice
Fab 1 Cut 1 ...2" square
Fab 1 Cut 2 ..3" squares and cut on the diagonal once



Fab 2 Cut 2...3" squares and cut on the diagonal once

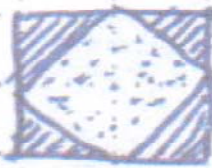
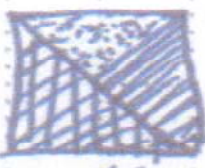


Fab 3 Cut 2...3" squares and cut on the diagonal once



Fab 4.. Cut 1...3 1/4" square and cut on the diagonal twice
Fab 4 Cut 2...2" squares and cut on the diagonal once

Now carefully sew these blocks together, square them to 2 1/2 " square and then put together as a regular 9 patch...



Make 4 of the first 2 and 1 of the last one.
