Did you have a scone at May meeting?

Tea Scones

2 cups flour

½ cup sugar

2 tsp Cream of Tartar

1 tsp Baking Soda

½ tsp salt

½ cup shortening

½ cup raisins

2 eggs

¼ cup milk

Peggy Sheehan

Preheat oven to 350

Prep & cooking time 30 mins

Grease cookie sheet.

Sift all dry ingredients together

Blend in shortening till fine crumbs

Break eggs & whisk in separate bowl

Add milk to eggs

Add wet, raisins to dry ingredients

Lightly fork mix together

Handle as little as needed

Divide dough into 2 equal parts

Pat each part into a round, flat shape & cut into 8 wedges

Place on cookie sheet about 1 inch apart

Bake 10-20 minutes till top very light brown

***Variation:** Omit raisins & put ½ cup of chopped fresh / frozen cranberries and the rind of 1 orange .Can also substitute orange juice for milk
