### Guest Speaker Last Meeting

Jeanette Petitpas Taylor: Chairperson of New Brunswick Advisory Council of the Status of Women.

#### *Notes of Interest:*

- ~work with victims of crime
  - ~app. 23 volunteers age range 23 to 80
  - ~ Access to Moncton, Riverview, and Dieppe
  - ~large majority of violence physical and sexual are against women
  - ~work towards preventing intergenerational cycle of violence
  - ~under 16 even though may not be abused children but are exposed and they are therefore a victim of abuse. Verbal abuse included.
  - ~work with victims of robberies
  - ~death notification as a result of a tragic event
  - ~80 quilts were donated
  - ~there are 2 quilts in each car at all times
- There is a need for more quilts approximate 40x45 or bigger. For more information contact Margaret Sawyer.
