A brief explanation of the game played, Fat Quarter Roll. All the members that participate in the game brought in 3 fat quarters. We had a basket in the middle of a table with approximately 13 members. One member starts the game by rolling 3 dice. (special dice with 4 marking L, R, C, and *) Depending on what was rolled depended on where the fat quarters ended up. L=pass to the left. R=pass to the right. C=center basket. *=you keep.
