Day 2 – After breakfast we will leave for Keepsake Quilting in Center Harbor, NH (no tax in NH) for 2-3 hrs. Have lunch and leave for Burlington, VT where we will be spending the night at the Holiday Inn, 802-419-9362.

Day 3 - After breakfast, we will leave for the Vermont Quilt Festival for approximately 5 hours. This is their 34th anniversary. This is the largest annual Quilt show and longest running in New England. There are over **400 Quilts** and **80 vendors**. It is being held at the Champlain Valley Exposition in Essex Junction in the new, fully air conditioned building and everything is all under one roof. We will be spending the night at the Comfort Inn, South Portland, ME. 207-775-0409.

Day 4 - We have to leave for home today but we will stop at Joanne Fabrics in Bangor and then have lunch at Oriental Jade (included) . We will be off to the Houlton border.
