

**The Greater Moncton Quilt Guild  
Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
Wednesday, June 14, 2006**

**In Attendance** – Executive Members: President - Kerri Delehanty; President-Elect – Susan Rumpel; Vice-President – Heather Arsenault; Recording Secretary – Roxanne LeBlanc; Registrar – Marilyn O'Brien; Program Coordinator – Vicki Donnelly; and the Treasurer, Susan Delaney, was absent.

**Call to Order** – The Regular Meeting of the Greater Moncton Quilt Guild was held at the Golden Age Club on June 14, 2006 and was called to order at 6:35 pm by the outgoing President, Kerri Delehanty.

**President's Report** – Kerri Delehanty thanked the members of the 2005-2006 Executive Committee and a long list of volunteers for their support during the past year. The meeting was then handed over to the new President, Susan Rumpel, who welcomed those in attendance and encouraged everyone to continue to support the Guild by volunteering and participating in upcoming activities. Pat Hume presented a gift to Kerri Delehanty on behalf of the Guild.

**Treasurer's Report** – The Vice-President presented the report and moved that it be accepted as read, seconded by Marilyn O'Brien.

**Minutes** – The minutes from the May Annual General Meeting were read by the Secretary and moved that they be accepted as read, seconded by Pat Hume.

**New Business:**

Job Jar - Three positions remain vacant: Christmas Party, Christmas Challenge, and Challenge Quilt. The President advised that if volunteers were not forthcoming, these activities could be in jeopardy of being cancelled this year.

**Anniversary Quilt Show** – The Show Chair, Betty Rice, reminded everyone that there are only 18 weeks left until the big event. The Yard Sale and Raffle Ticket volunteers were thanked for their efforts to raise funds. A meeting will be held on June 19, 2006, at Shirley Baillieul's residence for all Show Committee Chairs and any members who wish to attend. Marie Bernard added that volunteers for demonstrations at the show are still required, and a sign-up sheet was passed around.

**Correspondence** – Information regarding the Kennebecasis Valley Quilting Guild (KVQG) Quilt Retreat to be held October 16-18, 2006 was presented.

**Show and Share** – The President advised that anyone wishing to present a quilt at Show and Share who is not comfortable getting up in front of the members does not need to speak; they may write a few words about the quilt on a card which would then be read aloud by one of the Executive committee members. Also, Show and Share will be presented before the break to allow the quilts to be displayed during the break to encourage sharing of ideas. A draw was held from the names of the Show and Share participants, and Betty Rice won a \$20 gift certificate from The Covered Bridge Quiltery.

**Round Robin** – Instructions for the Round Robin were handed out. Jerri Burke explained that groups of eight would work best, as there are eight parts to the project. Individuals wishing to participate were encouraged to ask the Round Robin committee to assist them in finding a group.

**Attendance Draw** – The winner of the fat quarter was Vangie Soucie.

**Block of the Month:**

a) A total of 16 appliquéd blocks were won by Fernande Bourque. A draw was held from the names of those participating in this activity during the last year, and Audrey Roach won a paid membership (\$25) for 2006-2007.

b) Next year's Block of the Month committee passed out instructions for a Pieced Pansy block for September's draw. The theme for next year will be floral.

**50/50 Draw** – Joan Smith won \$37.00.

**Break** – A 30 minute break was called to allow everyone to enjoy the finger foods and desserts and to vote for Viewer's Choice from among the 13 Anniversary Challenge Quilt entries that were displayed throughout the meeting.

**Anniversary Challenge Quilt** – Diane Williams presented the award for Viewer's Choice to Shirley Baillieul, and the award for Most Effective Use of Feature Fabric was given to Jerri Burke.

**UFO** – This year's UFO was coordinated by Pat Hume. A total of \$61 was collected for unfinished projects.

**Mystery Quilt** - This year's mystery quilt was Hayes Corner. A total of (6-8?) quilts were displayed.

**Centerpiece Draw** – The centerpieces of potted plants from each table were won by those sitting in chairs marked with the stickers.

**Program** – Vicky Donnelly asked everyone to bring in three fat quarters for September's Program activity, which will be a game with an opportunity to win 30 fat quarters.

**Adjournment** – The meeting was adjourned at 8:25 pm.
