

**The Greater Moncton Quilt Guild  
Minutes of the Regular Meeting  
Wednesday, November 14, 2007**

**In Attendance – Executive:** President – Susan Rumpel; Recording Secretary – Roxanne LeBlanc; Treasurer - Susan Delaney; Registrar – Marilyn O'Brien; Program Coordinator – Peggy Sheehan; Absent: Vice-President – Heather Arsenault.

**Call to Order** – The Regular Meeting of the Greater Moncton Quilt Guild was held at the Golden Age Club on November 14, 2007 and was called to order at 7:10 pm.

**Program** – Susan Rumpel introduced Anita Zobens, “The Thread Lady”, who gave a very informative presentation and handout on needles. She also had a large display of threads, marking tools, quilting books, and other items for sale.

**President’s Report** – The President welcomed everyone to the meeting. There were 7 new members in attendance. She thanked Anita Zobens for her presentation, and a draw was held for a door prize that was won by Susan Delaney.

**Minutes** – The minutes from the October meeting were read; there was an error noted and corrected. The minutes were seconded by Kim Larracy.

**Treasurer’s Report** - Opening balance was \$4,172.91; revenue of \$485.00; expenses of \$194.60, and a closing balance of \$4,463.31 of which \$725.90 plus an outstanding deposit of \$33 is set aside for the Gathering of the Guilds and \$1,270.94 from the Quilt Show funds (\$1,000 for future quilt shows and \$270.94 for the library), leaving \$2,466.47 available for the Guild. The report was seconded by Bridget Daly.

**Old Business** - The Laurie Swim books have been received and distributed.

**New Business** – The Christmas Party will be held December 12 at the Moncton Golf and Country Club starting with cocktails at 6 p.m. and dinner at 7 p.m. The cost is \$25 per person and the deadline for payment is December 8. A traditional turkey dinner will be served. Anyone with special dietary requirements was asked to provide details to Susan Rumpel. There will be a gift exchange with a limit of \$15 or something handmade.

**Block of the Month** – Gilberte Comeau won 20 “November Sunrise” blocks. The pattern for December is “Christmas Bows,” and printed instructions were handed out. The pattern will also be available on the website.

**50/50 Draw** – Harriet Purdy won \$38.00.

**Mystery Quilt** – Pat Hume presented the final part of the Mystery Quilt and displayed her completed project. Everyone completing the quilt was asked to bring it to the Christmas Party for display.
