<p>Program Louanna introduced our presenter for the evening Martha Davidson. Her topic: “The Filling” to the sandwich: Batting. Martha gave information on what kinds of batting are on the market and reviewed What batting would be more suited to your projects, depending on your personal Tastes and the effects you want your quilt to have. Handouts were given to each member on the Yardage needed to buy for backing In addition to batting sizes and what is needed for hand or machine quilting. A tip for those who use navy’s, blacks, solid dark colors for you backing, Use black Batting –no “white fuzzies” coming through your fabric. Martha also pointed out about the Queen and King sizes bed measurements and the height of the mattresses. If you want your quilt to hang below the mattress top you need to adjust the size quilt, in most cases the quilt needs to be more square. Martha had lots of examples of different types of batting and how they felt and looked in the finished quilts and table runners.
